

WINDOWS UPDATE

We are on schedule to have the windows installed April 21 and 22 at the parsonage. We are actively fundraising for this project, so order as many Scrip cards as possible, and keep eating at the luncheons! Don't forget the special envelopes you received last month, if that's the way you would like to contribute to this project.

Just to review the project: we started planning for the roof and windows to be replaced at the parsonage in October 2011. Several bids were accepted for each project over a period of two years. We chose to replace the roof first, and the windows as soon as possible afterwards. The roof was completed and paid for in full last fall. Fundraising, coin jars, and generous giving helped us "Raise the Roof."

Now, with the help of all of us, we hope to have enough funds to pay for the windows in full by Easter. The total cost of this project is \$9,346.00. We received eight bids for this job, so please do not think that the decision was made in haste. A deposit of \$2,000.00 has been paid. We have raised:

- \$520-luncheons
- \$224.30–Scrip Program
- \$1,278—donations to the windows fund
- \$460 (estimate)–Sarris Easter candy sales

In addition, we have \$591.36 in carryover from "Raise the Roof" fundraising, and Ad-Council approved \$5,000.00 to be pulled from reserved funds if necessary.

There are currently 21 double hung windows in the parsonage which will be replaced with 10 double hung windows, 5 threesection slider windows and one picture window. The



parsonage has also been lead tested, which is required by law when removing windows and/or doors from any residence built prior to 1978. The test was negative. If you have any questions concerning this project, please see Kris Peters.

PLUMBING

Once again, the sewer clogged and Chris Pazak Plumbing came to fix it. We will not be able to put off the repairs needed any longer, so prepare yourselves for some dirt in the church.



We will start digging up the floor in the old youth room as soon as possible, and a vent will be needed alongside the building. We plan to start as soon as the yard sale is over, so please attend the sale, so everything is gone and rooms will be clear.

Our next scheduled luncheon is April 6, so please plan to attend. The last (hopefully) luncheon will be May 4.
