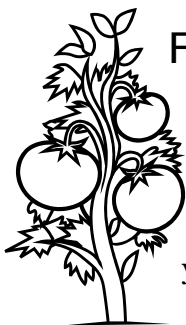
SonTreasure ISLAND

Father's Day Tomato Plants

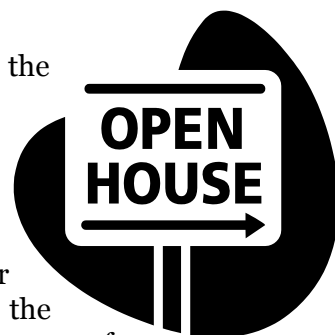
