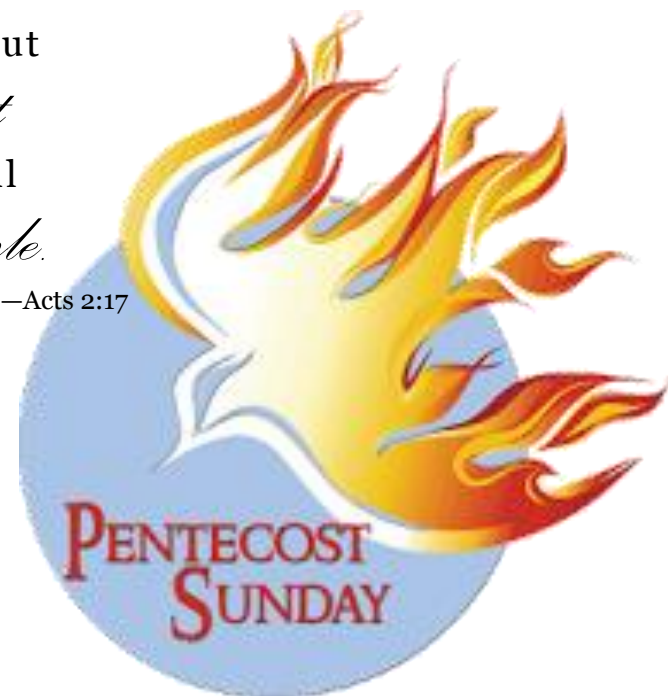
Food Drive – Next Sunday is the last day to donate boxes of instant pudding to the food bank. We've collected 60 boxes; our goal is 90.
