

Health Kits

During November, Trinity is collecting items for health kits to send to refugees through UMCOR. In late November or early December, we will have a packing party to assemble the kits and prepare them for shipping. See the list below for items in the kit. Don't remove items from their packaging and don't include items not on the list.

Health Kit Items (each kit contains):

- 1 Hand towel (15" x 25" to 17" x 27")
- 1 Washcloth
- 1 Comb (sturdy, longer than 6"; rattail combs and combs without handles are acceptable with a minimum of 6" of teeth)
- 1 Metal nail file or clipper
- 1 Bath-size bar of soap (3 oz or larger size; no Ivory or Jergens soap due to moisture content)
- 1 Toothbrush (adult size)
- 6 Adhesive bandages (3/4" to 1" size; e.g. Band-Aids)
- 1 One-gallon size, sealable, plastic bag
- \$1 to purchase toothpaste
