Native American Ministries Day – Today we recognize the contributions that Native Americans have made to our society. Your donations on this Special Sunday support outreach across the country and provide seminary scholarships for Native Americans.

Bethany House Academy – In 2002, the University of Pittsburgh Center for Social and Urban Research compiled rankings for 90 neighborhoods in the City of Pittsburgh. Northview Heights was ranked:

- #1 in poverty for children (under 18) and in poverty overall
- #3 in adult (16+) male unemployment
- #5 in adult (16+) female unemployment
- #4 in female headed households with children under age 18
- #8 by percentage of population (age 25 and older) with less than a high school diploma
- #75 by percentage of students (K-12) enrolled in private school #72 by percentage of population enrolled in college

What has Bethany House done? For those who participate in Bethany House Academy:

- 90% of children are current on all immunizations
- 80% of youth have improved attitudes toward school and education
- 75% improved their grades in math and English
- 70% of participants become members of the honor roll
- 86% increased their self-esteem and self-confidence
- 90% improved their cultural awareness/identity and community mobilization activities
