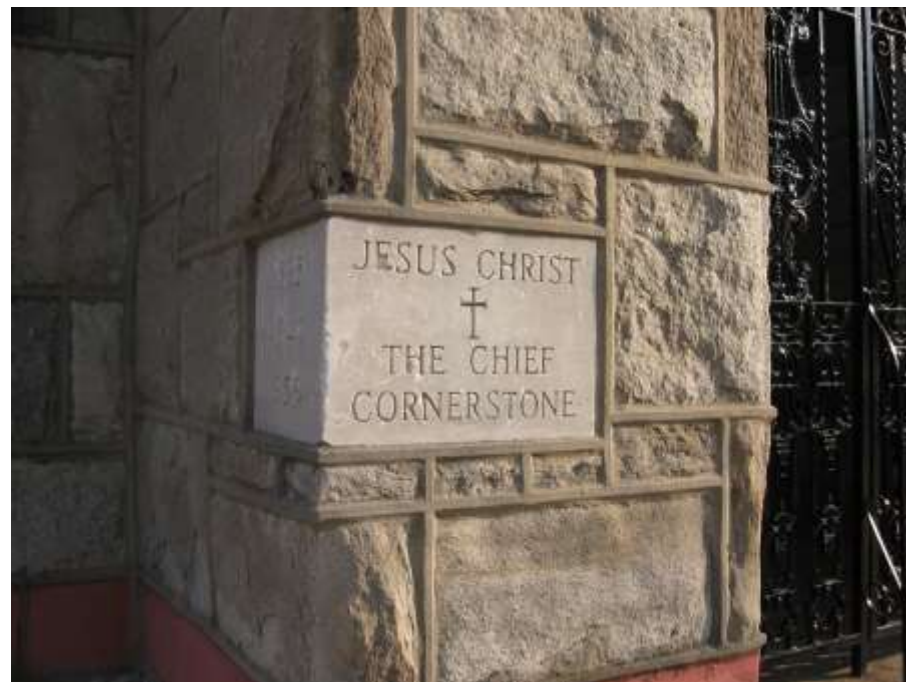
Prayer Partners – The sign-up sheet is in the vestibule for September-October-November. Sign up by August 27.

- 1 pair blunt (rounded) tip scissors—no plastic scissors
- 3 pads of paper—spiral- or top-bound pads; 100-150 sheets of loose-leaf paper can be substituted for 1 pad; no composition books
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener—must be at least 1 inch long
- 1 30-centimeter ruler—hard or flexible
