## School Kits

The following items make up one school kit. Cartoon characters on items are okay. Keep in mind that we cannot send items with advertisements or items with religious, patriotic, military or camouflage symbols.

- 1 pair blunt (rounded) tip scissors—no plastic scissors
- 3 pads of paper—spiral- or top-bound pads; 100-150 sheets of loose-leaf paper can be substituted for 1 pad; no composition books

- 1 30-centimeter ruler—hard or flexible
