

A Slice of Church History (photo on front cover)



This addition to the sanctuary was designed by architect Bud Parkins. Its purpose was to conceal the speakers for the organ purchased in 1947. To paraphrase Mr. Parkins, the radiant arms represent the temple curtain split from top to bottom at the moment of Christ's death. The cross is the Light of the World—Jesus. The circle is the world. The two figures at the base represent the people of the world kneeling before Christ.
