We will collect them throughout October and assemble kits on October 29 after the worship service. Only items listed may be included in the kits so take the list with you on your shopping trip!

- 1 hand towel—15” x 25” to 17” x 27”  
(no kitchen, cleaning or microfiber towels)
- 1 washcloth
- 1 comb—sturdy, 6” or longer; rattail combs and combs without handles are okay; minimum of 6” of teeth  
(no pocket combs or picks)
- 1 metal nail file or nail clippers  
(no emery boards)
- 1 bath-size soap—3-oz and larger sizes  
(no Jergens or Ivory soap due to moisture content)
- 1 toothbrush—adult size
- 6 adhesive bandages—3/4” to 1” size
