Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

According to biblegateway.com, the word "church" shows up 118 times in the New Testament

(NRSV). Almost every reference speaks of a community of believers. Groups of people who function in such a way to worship God, uplift and support one another, help each other draw closer to God, pray for each other, hold each other accountable in love, and provide services to those in need. I am certain there are a few things you may have thought of that I didn't. But the point that stands out the most to me is highlighted in 1 Corinthians 16:19. "The churches of Asia send greetings. Aquila and Prisca, together with the church in their house, greet you warmly in the Lord."

In this verse we see groups of God's believers from all over the country loving, supporting, and caring for one another. This scripture shows a display of camaraderie and community between a few groups of different people that still see each other as part of something bigger than themselves. Paul is not encouraging competition with one another but cooperation and unity.

Verse 19 also highlights the meaning of the word "church" according to Paul. It seems that for Paul, church was not a synonym for synagogue, temple, or even a place of worship. The place of worship here is a house. But church is instead a community, the group—in this case women and men united by and through Jesus Christ.

The neat thing about this is that on Sunday morning, we are not going to church (we in our belief and love of Jesus are already a part of it), but the church is gathering for worship, education, spiritual growth, mutual encouragement, and fellowship.

As always, I look forward to our time of gathering. It is an extra reminder that I am not alone and that we can do whatever God lays before us together. I can't wait to see you as we gather in Jesus' presence together.


Our annual Blessing of the Pets will take place outside the church (usually on Trinity House steps) on Sunday, October 3 at 6 p.m.


