#### Hygiene Kit

- **1 Comb**: sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth; no picks or pocket combs
- **1 Toenail or Fingernail clipper**: no emery boards or metal nail files
- **1 Bath-size soap** (3-oz. bar or larger) in original packaging; no Ivory or Jergen's
- **1 Adult toothbrush** in original packaging; no personal advertising
- **10 Adhesive bandages** (3/4 x 3 inches): common household bandages such as Band-Aid, Curad, Nexcare, store or other brand

#### 1 One-gallon resealable plastic bag

Buy enough to complete an entire kit or buy one or two specific items. A donation box is in the vestibule.
